Haitian Relief 2010

*“Whoso stoppeth his ears at the cry of the poor,
he also shall cry himself, but shall not be heard.” Proverbs 21:13*

As we have watched the news coming out of Haiti, our hearts have been moved with compassion and sorrow for the people. Haiti is one of the poorest nations on God's earth. The people are desperately crying out for help, and so many are hungry and homeless. We as an independent Baptist aviation ministry have been called upon to help in the Haitian relief effort. Unfortunately, we are not able to go it alone! We need all the help we can get!

Another independent Baptist Ministry, Operation Renewed Hope, has asked Wings to partner with them and fly relief into Haiti. Operation Renewed Hope has been working with Brother Dave Spangler, who is a missionary pilot in the Bahamas and has already flown several trips into Haiti on behalf of ORH. Unfortunately, Brother Spangler just experienced an engine failure on his Piper Aztec and is currently out of operation.

As a result of Brother Spangler's engine problem, a unique opportunity to help Wings As Eagles, as well as Brother Spangler and his engine replacement. Brother Spangler has been an integral part of our Flight Camp each year. The Cessna 172 aircraft used in the camp was purchased from Brother Spangler, and we still owe Brother Spangler \$31,500. The replacement engine for his Piper Aztec, which was being used for his ministry in the Bahamas and the Haiti trips, will cost about \$30,000. Here is a real opportunity to help Wings with the Cessna 172 debt and help with the engine replacement cost at the same time. Please seek God's will and do what you can to help! A gift of any amount will be a great help and great blessing! If you would give a gift to Wings As Eagles toward the 172 debt, that would enable us to immediately send it on to Brother Spangler and get him flying again with the relief effort as well.

As was mentioned earlier, we are not able to bear the cost of the Haiti relief outreach alone. We are calling upon God's people to help with this urgent need. Over and above the Cessna 172 and Dave Spangler's engine replacement project, we desperately need funds for fuel and operating expenses. We understand that fuel in that area can run as high as \$6.00 per gallon. Then, of course, there are landing fees, customs fees, etc.

We do not actively seek support outside of the independent Baptists as other ministries do. We look to this family to enable us to do what God has called us to do. We are asking you to open your bowels of mercy and give sacrificially, helping not only with humanitarian needs but also with getting the much needed Word of God to the Haitian community. *“...let us not love in word, neither in tongue; but in deed and in truth.”*

Not everyone can go to Haiti, but everyone can give something of their resources, making it possible for Wings As Eagles and others to do what they cannot do.
