SESSION DESCRIPTION

Session One:

Jason Brenenstuhl - What is the Growing Process?

In the early 1900's Missionary Florent D. Toirac worked in the jungles of Haiti and Dominican Republic. During his ministry he was privileged to see numerous witch doctors accept Christ as their Saviour. Within thirty days of their salvation experiences, more than half of those witch doctors died. Why was this? Were they really saved? What does the Bible say about Demon oppression and Demon possession? How did their lifestyle before salvation affect their new life in Christ? This session will explore what the Bible has to say about these topics.

Session Two (Split):

Jason Brenenstuhl - How do I Help People Grow? - Specific ways to challenge teens and adults.

Heather Brenenstuhl - How do I Help People Grow? - Specific ways to challenge children.

Many of us see the needs of others, but are unable to meet those needs. We are unable to "connect the dots" from their problem to their possibilities. These sessions will explore the specifics of how to relate to, understand, and equip others to get victory in their lives.

Session Three (Split):

Jason Brenenstuhl - Who is in charge of growth? - When a visitor walks through the door, who is responsible to help them? Who should visit them at their house? Pastor King would like to disciple everyone, but it is physically not possible. God uses each one of us -- but how do WE work together to reach others? This session will give some practical guidelines to follow to help make the whole group a useful tool in God's hands to reach others.

Alan Ives - Instructed in the Songs of the Lord - What should the psalms, hymns and spiritual songs mentioned in Ephesians 5 and Colossians 3 sound like? We know that we are not to be conformed to this world, but how should our music be different from the world's music? David's musicians were "instructed in the songs of the Lord." This session will cover some of the Biblical descriptions of God's songs, and how that applies to our praises to God.
