Dear friends and family,

We welcome Chloe Elisabeth to our family in Cameroon! She was born on June 26th at 10:30pm at Mbingo Baptist Hospital. She weighed 5 pounds 13.5 ounces. She is now over one month old and is doing great getting a little fatter and waking up to the world. Chloe has a big sister and brother who adore her. Elias will often sit down, hold out both of his hands and say “pease” wanting to hold Chloe. Elena is very sweet with her doing what she can to help. We are so thankful to the Lord for this new life that He has allowed to love and raise for Him. Abby did great during her delivery and is recovering well. The Lord has sent several people to be a help to Abby. Abby Joshua recently arrived from Michigan to help us for a month, and she has jumped right in to life in Africa.

It is a little late this year, but we are full swing into the rainy season. That means “winter” and cooler temperatures! I have not been able to fly for a few weeks due to either high winds or clouds or rain. One of my last flights was very sad as I flew a father and mother from the hospital back to their village without their little girl. I had flown the family out of the bush to get treatment for their 10 year old girl, and she didn’t respond to the treatment at the hospital. It was a very sad sight to see the mourners gather at the airstrip on their return wailing as they accompanied the mother and father on their way home. Tears came to my eyes several times from the time I got the sad phone call to the time that I dropped the family back in Akwaya. Pray for more laborers to be able to reach these people for Jesus Christ.

On another note for the plane, we praise the Lord that the engine repair is now completely paid for! Thank you to those who have given extra gifts in the last few months. We are still trying to raise that last half of the purchase price for the Glastar of which about \$24,000 remains. Please continue to pray for the aviation part of our ministry.

We also wish to thank our friends, family, and churches who have given money in the last few months to help us buy a car. We now have enough to buy an imported four-wheel drive car and have people looking for one for us in the industrial capital and port-city of Douala. Pray that we’ll be able to find one soon. Because of some other extra gifts, we have also been able to add a new washing machine and electric hot water heater for the house this month. We had been without either for several months. With this new heater, our guests have hot water in their bathroom as well. We have learned to be thankful for all the conveniences the Lord allowed us to have or not have!

We praise the Lord for those this last month who have trusted Jesus Christ as their Saviour including a prisoner who visited our church last Sunday, a lady at the Babungo Bible Study, and a girl and boy in our church who were both saved at Camp Joy! We had two baptized and plan to baptize a few more in the near future. Please continue to pray!

Thank you to those who helped to make our birthday month special. We received numerous cards, emails, packages, and even some gifts through suitcases with Abby J. With Chloe joining me in June, she now finds herself in our busy birthday month that stretches from June 23rd to July 24th. Elena just turned four and Elias two! How precious they are to us. Please pray for them that they would give their heart and life to Christ early. We thank you all for your financial support, and earnestly desire your continued prayers for our family and ministries.
